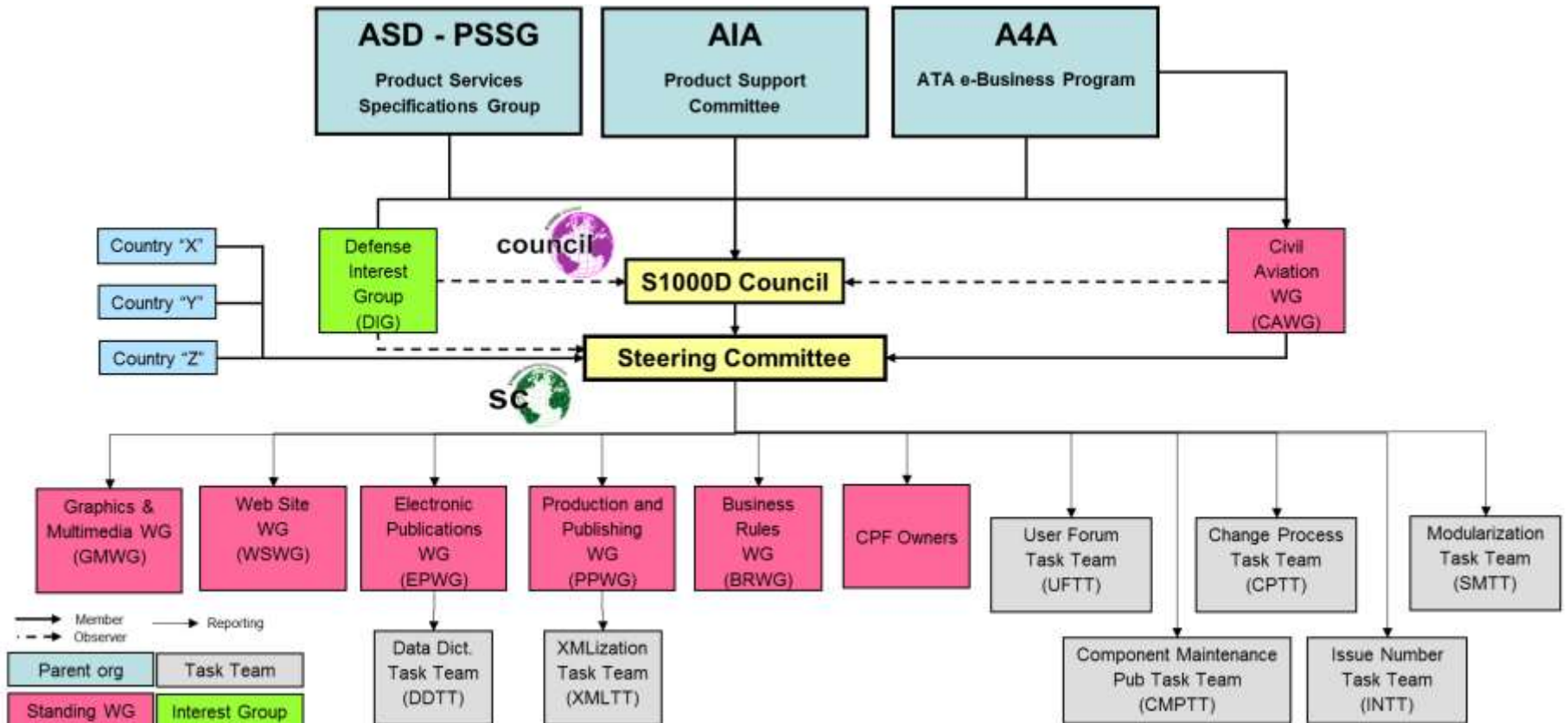

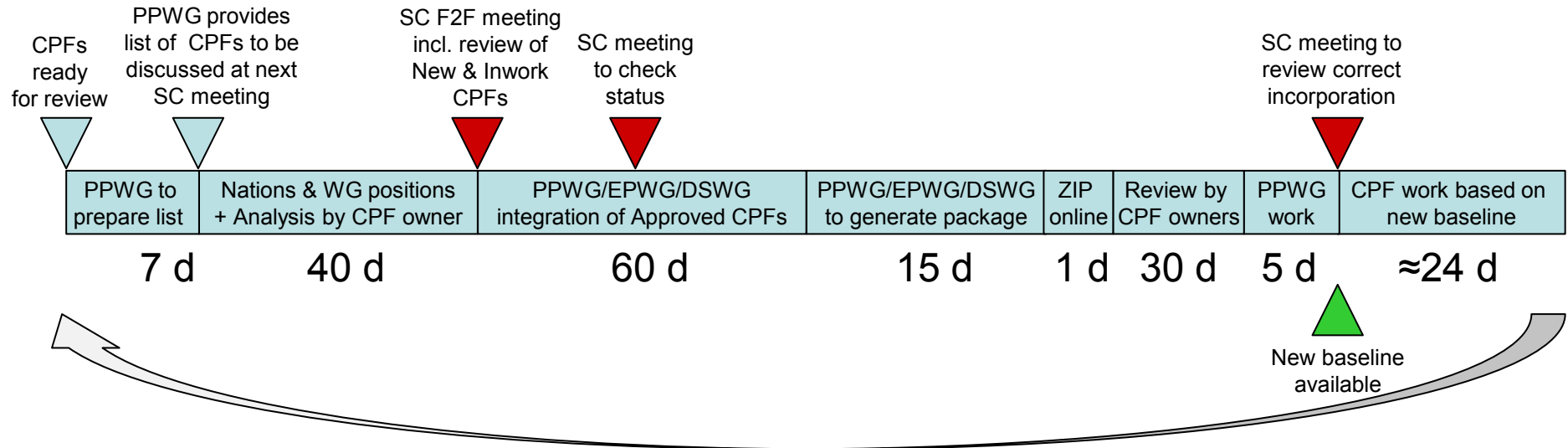

- S1000D issue 5.0 package, include
 - The specification
 - XML schema package
 - Default BREX
 - Data dictionary
 - Bike data set
 - Front matter samples
 - Example SNS
 - Project decision points index
 - Excel
 - Unit of measurement list
 - Functionally matrix

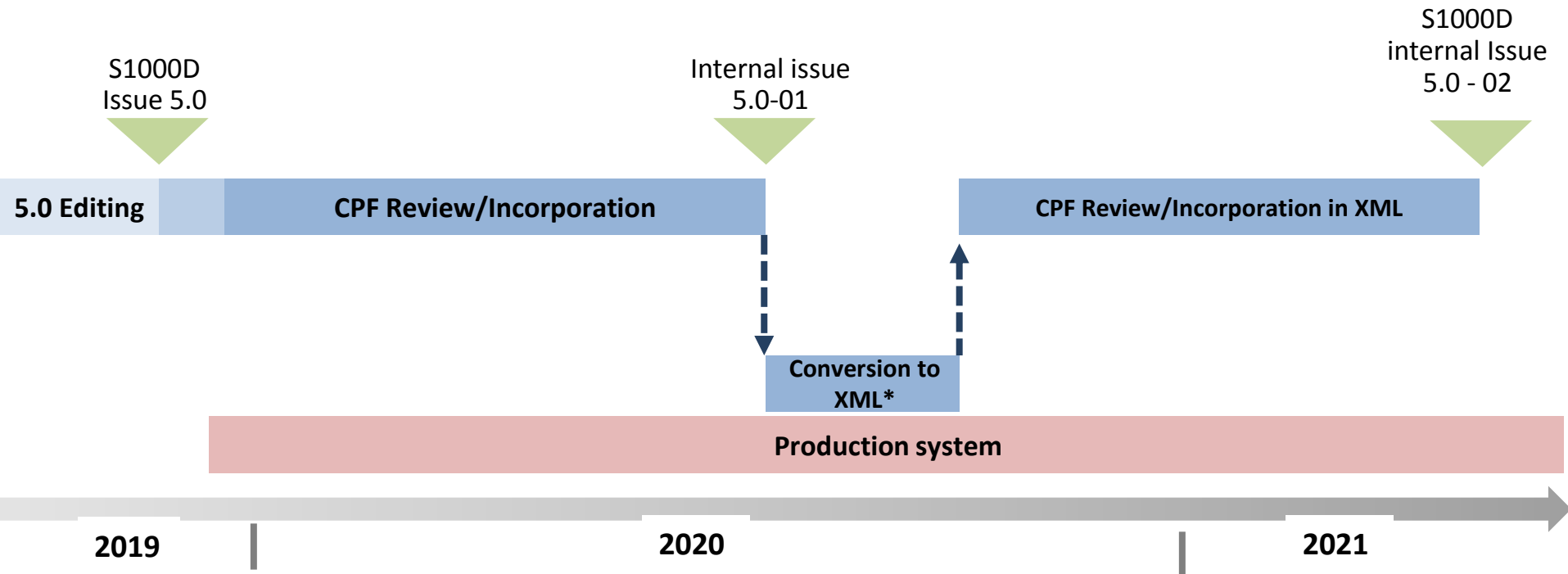


The new change process tested and works - Issue 5.0 released



- Min duration of one cycle to create a new baseline (Internal or Published S1000D Issue) ≈ 182 days
- Review of Inwork CPFs at SC F2F meetings → two SC F2F meetings per year
- WebEx meetings in between F2F meetings to review New CPFs and review correct incorporation

S1000D Roadmap

- Validation
- Move from Word to XML
- New publishing method
 - New stylesheet
- Re-work of issues found
- New numbers of all illustration
- etc

S1000D development - Overview

- S1000D 5.0 (Released 2019-08-08)
 - Now available on www.S1000D.org.
 - Business rule template (BR template) will be provided in the near future.
- S1000D 5.0-01
 - Next internal issue
 - Preparation for XMLization
- S1000D 5.0-02
 - New production system for Production and Publishing Working Group (PPWG)
 - Edit in XML

Next public issue (“Published” issue of S1000D) currently “*aiming*” for the fourth quarter of 2021.

Beyond issue 6

- We stop using minor updates numbers
 - No more -> issue 5.1, issue 5.2
 - Instead -> issue 6, issue 7, etc.
- Patches will be identified with a alpha
 - 5.0.A, 6.A, 6.B, etc
- Continue working with updates
 - 67 "New" CPFs
 - 16 CPF in work
- Modularization (SMTT)

30 years in work

- 30 years since the first issue of S1000D was signed
